

## 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 588

November 27, 2007 – Introduced by Representatives JORGENSEN, BLACK, HRAYCHUCK, BERCEAU, TURNER and A. WILLIAMS, cosponsored by Senator LEIBHAM, Referred to Committee on Natural Resources.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 287.81 (2) (intro.) of the statutes; **relating to:** littering and  
2 providing a penalty.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, the maximum penalty for littering is a forfeiture (civil penalty) of \$500. Littering includes depositing solid waste on public or private property, other than in a trash receptacle or a solid waste facility, and failing to remove a vehicle from the waters of the state. This bill increases the maximum forfeiture for littering to \$1,000.
