



# Wisconsin Wildlife Federation Wolf Delisting Petition

**To the Honorable Kenneth Salazar, Secretary of the Interior and the Wisconsin Congressional Delegation:**

The undersigned citizens are asking that you immediately use all of your authority to delist the gray wolf in Wisconsin from Federal Endangered Species List. There have been repeated efforts to delist the wolf from the list over the last five years and the wolf population in Wisconsin is estimated by government agencies to be over 700 animals. The population goal for delisting the species according to the Federal Wolf Recovery Plan was 100 animals combined in Wisconsin and Michigan. The gray wolf is causing substantial depredation in the state on livestock, hunting dogs and pets. The failure to delist the wolf from the Endangered Species List is substantially reducing respect for the animal, the Federal Endangered Species Act and state and federal resource management agencies.
